

Coffin Butte Landfill Rules & Requirements

The following rules and procedures must be followed by all vehicles that enter the Coffin Butte Landfill. These rules are in place to provide a safe and efficient environment for our employees and our customers.

- We only accept non-hazardous municipal solid waste – no liquids, paint or chemicals.
- All persons outside of the vehicle unloading garbage on the tipping face must wear a safety vest and helmet.
- Every person who exits the vehicle in the public drop-off area is required to wear appropriate personal protective equipment.
- All vehicles transporting materials to Coffin Butte Landfill are subject to vehicle inspection and weigh check.
- All loads entering the Landfill must be completely and securely covered / all openings secured to prevent the escape of any material. No debris on top, sides or either end of the vehicle.
- All coverings shall remain in place and secure until at the unloading areas. Special waste and industrial loads may be examined or asked to remove tarps on the scales for inspection.
- All traffic shall weigh in at the scale complex. Your vehicle will be scanned by radiation detectors. If anything is detected, follow the direction of site personnel.
- With the exception of dump trailers, the general public may dispose of waste in the general public area only.
- Dump trailer loads may dispose of waste on the tipping face.
- If directed to unload in a separate area for random load inspection, do not leave the inspection area until directed to do so by the site personnel.
- Any unacceptable waste will be reloaded into the vehicle and removed from the Landfill.
- Do not leave the unloading area until visually confirming the vehicle is completely empty, doors closed, secured and covered.
- No smoking is allowed on the Landfill property.
- Any demolition materials manufactured prior to 2004 that are brought to site must be accompanied with an asbestos and lead paint survey, which can be found at the following DEQ Web site:
